

IEEE Open Journal of System Engineering (OJSE) is an open access technical journal devoted to the multidisciplinary aspects of systems engineering. Systems engineering involves elements of model-based systems engineering; digital thread; requirements generation, flowdown, tracking, needs analysis, and validation/verification; integration and test; and full life cycle support of the target system. OJSE deals primarily with the science, methodology, and tools of systems engineering, rather than the results of the application of systems engineering that is the focus of other IEEE journals.



About the Journal

OJSE is an Open Access journal and articles are provided free to the public. The publication costs of Open Access articles are paid by the authors. For 2024, publication costs are projected to be 975 USD for a 10-page manuscript. OJSE is sponsored by the consortium of IEEE Aerospace and Electronic Systems Society, IEEE Systems, Man, and Cybernetics Society, and IEEE Systems Council.









OJSE seeks scholarly papers that report original research on the methodologies, tools, principles, and applied engineering aspects of the process of systems engineering for complex systems.

OJSE also seeks proposals for special issues.

The manuscripts submitted to OJSE should present original work in the scope of the journal and must be exclusively submitted to this journal, must not have been published before, and must not be under consideration for publication elsewhere. Significantly enhanced and expanded versions of papers published in conference proceedings can be submitted as long as a detailed description of the enhancements is provided. The manuscripts should be prepared according to detailed instructions provided in the Authors' Instructions for IEEE Access at https://ieeeaccess.ieee.org /guide-for-authors/preparing-your-article/, where templates for MS Word and LaTex are available. Since IEEE must own the copyright of the technical contributions that it publishes, an electronic Copyright Form must be submitted at the time of manuscript submission.
